Cruising is now a little more environmentally-friendly at PortMiami, as it launches a shore power facility. This means cruise ships arriving into the port no longer have to use their engines for power while docked.

Carnival Conquest was the first cruise ship to plug into the landside electrical facility. Carnival Cruise Line president Christine Duffy says it is an important milestone for the cruise line's hometown. "We continue to implement important initiatives that have kept us ahead of our ambitious goals to reduce emissions, and this new shore power capability will allow our ships to rely on the electrical grid to power our ships while in port." The shore power connections are available at five cruise berths.
